Dr. Naveen Kumar B.T., President welcomed all the members of Society of Fisheries and Life Sciences. He briefed the Annual Progress Report-2017 and the agenda for the meeting. The following agenda items were discussed and decided for further needful action.

1. Discussion on 1ST Indian Fisheries Video Interviewer Award (1st IFVIA)-

The body proposed to conduct 1ST Indian Fisheries Video Interviewer Award (1st IFVIA) for Students and Research Scholars to participate in *1st Indian Fisheries Video Interviewer Award* with theme “A dialogue on Blue Revolution”. The Award will be given based on originality of e-technology used (reordered video) pertaining to mentioned specific theme, quality of questions framed, clarity of pronunciation and other criteria. The body proposed Mr. Kumar Naik A.S., Treasurer as Organizing Secretary and Dr. Naveen Kumar B.T and Dr. Jitendra Kumar as a Convener of 1st IFVIA and all other executive members as organizing committee members. The body unanimously approved the same.

2. Video interview of fisheries stalwarts to obtain their views and contribution towards the Indian fisheries (50 Years Journey of Fisheries College)

In view of Golden Jubilee celebration of the College of Fisheries, Mangaluru, Society of Fisheries and Life Sciences (SFLS) has planned to present a video containing the past, present and future of Indian Fisheries as seen through the eye of highly qualified fisheries professionals (staff and graduates) from the Fisheries College Mangaluru. This video will be made by conducting an Interview of stalwart to obtain their opinions and views for the betterment of fisheries development in the country. These stalwarts will be selected based on their expertise in various fisheries disciplines in the country and abroad. The messages from these experts in the documentary video would encourage and motivate the youth to face the future challenges in Indian fisheries, and it will be presented on the occasion of Golden Jubilee event. In this regard, the body proposed a tentative list of stalwarts will be made by Dr. Prakash Patil and Dr. Naveen Kumar B.T. considering their significant contribution to the fisheries in concerned areas. Dr. Harsha Nayak and Mr. Himanshu S Swain will coordinate the same. The body unanimously approved the same.

3. 1st Blue Fisheries Science Congress - (1 st BFSC) with theme “Blue revolution and food security-A way forward” (Funding opportunities to Organize conferences)

The body proposed to conduct a national level conference “1st Blue Fisheries Science Congress” (1st BFSC) with theme “Blue revolution and food security-A way forward” with jointly organized by the Society of Fisheries and Life Sciences, College of Fisheries, Mangaluru and AFSIB, Mangaluru at College of Fisheries, Mangalore. The body proposed Dr. S.K. Girisha, Vice President and Dr. Prakash Patil to take initiation for the same. All other executive members will be serving as organizing committee members. The body unanimously approved the same.

4. Discussion about Publication of Book of Pharmacology and Toxicology

Dr. Prakash Patil has proposed to publish book of Pharmacology and Toxicology from Society. The ISBN number will be taken/registered behalf of SFLS. Dr. Prakash Patil will be doing the process of registration of International Standard Book Number from Raja Rammohun Roy ISBN Agency, Department of Higher Education, Ministry of Human Resource Development, Parliament Street, New Delhi. 5. Preparation of Annual Progress Report- 2017-18

6. Fellow Member of the Society

The body proposed to start Fellow Member of the Society. This membership level designated "Fellow of the Society" is to recognize members who have made sustained and outstanding technical contributions in areas of interest to Society of Fisheries and Life Sciences (SFLS). Fellow members are given preference in the early publication of the manuscript after approval of their manuscripts from experts. The body also decided that all the 18 executive member of the society also entitled and designated as Fellow of the Society "FSFLS". Tiwari, Retired Professor, NDUAT, U.P. and two executive committee members of SFLS (Dr. Naveen Kumar B.T. and Dr Jitendra Kumar).The body unanimously approved the same.

7. Fisheries and Life Science Awards: 2018

The body proposed to announce the call for application for Fisheries and Life Science Awards- 2018. The Fisheries and Life Science Awards objective is to identify and award outstanding contributions in the field of Fisheries and Life Sciences. The evaluation criteria followed by SFLS panel based on the parameters like innovation, published research paper, review, popular article, books, books chapters, PI ship of projects, seminar organizer, a workshop attended, invited talks given, Radio/TV talks, the patent awarded & consultancy project undertook etc. The guidelines, application format and eligibility criteria will be made by two external experts (Prof. A. P. Rao, Director of Extension, NDUAT, U.P. and Dr. N.P. Tiwari, Retired Professor, NDUAT, U.P. and three executive committee members of SFLS (Dr. Naveen Kumar B.T, Mr. Kumar Naik

A.S. and Dr Jitendra Kumar). The following Awards were discussed and unanimously approved by executive body.

Award Eligibility Criteria

a) Best Scientist Awards

The Best Scientist Award recognizes the candidate who is actively engaged in R&D, and who have shown great potential to be a world-class scientist in their fields of Fisheries and Life Science.

b) International Achievement Award

The objective of the Award for International Achievement is to recognize an individual for sustained interest and involvement in international activities that bring recognition and contribute to the mission of the country in the international area.

c) Best Faculty Award

The Best Faculty Award recognizes the person who had made a major contribution towards the teaching, research & extension activities of Indian Fisheries.

d) Young Scientist Awards

The Young Scientist Award recognizes the person who is actively engaged in R&D, and who have shown great potential to be a good researcher in their fields of Fisheries and Life Science.


8. New life membership registration and coordinator for the respective college:




